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Put simply, a thin, hollow needle slides through the foil and cork into the bottle. The bottle is then pressurised with argon (a harmless gas sans odor and taste), which pushes wine back out through the needle and into your glass without letting any oxygen into the bottle. Once the needle is removed, argon is left in its place (hence no oxidation), the cork reseals itself and the remaining wine continues to naturally age as if it was never touched. Instead of coarsely extracting by soaking the botanicals in ethanol as most gins distillers do, the botanicals are not steeped or even allowed into contact with the neutral spirit: they are packed into a "flavour basket" through which the 95.6% pure alcohol vapour passes on its way to be condensed back into liquid. This leaves the impurities and volatile oils behind...the resulting gin is light, fragrant and balanced.

In the mouth the juniper develops into a crispness nicely balanced by a soft spiciness. A classic."

Martin Millers -*elderflower tonic*- **12**

Born out of Love, Obsession and some degree of Madness.'

Martin Miller and his two friends, David Bromige and Andreas Versteegh, kicked off the whole gin 'new wave' back in 1999

with the launch of Martin Miller's eponymous gin involving a little Love, Obsession and, it has to be admitted, more than a Degree of Madness.

VODKA

Tito's Vodka (USA) **10**

Tito's Vodka is a small batch, gluten-free vodka made in small-batches in Austin, Texas, by Tito Beveridge. It's distilled six times in a pot still and filtered to reach the level of quality Tito desires for his spirit

Ketel One (Holland) **9**

The Master Distiller uses a categorisation called the 4Fs to highlight what makes Ketel One Vodka so unique. **Fragrance** Nosing Ketel One Vodka will return hints of citrus and honey. **Flavor** After a sip of Ketel One Vodka, you'll taste a crisp, unmistakable coolness. **Feel** Ketel One Vodka generously and smoothly coats the tongue. The finish of Ketel One Vodka leaves a lively tingle- its quality.

Grey Goose (France) **10**

A clean nose with a slight mix sweetness as well as subtle nut and pepper gently arising. A smooth palate with cracked pepper, liquorice and butter with a lingering aniseed flavour. Creates a rounded finish.

Absolut (Sweden) **9**

Absolut Vodka is made exclusively from natural ingredients, and unlike other vodkas, it doesn't contain any added sugar. In fact Absolut is a pure vodka. Big on the nose with soft caramel, vanilla, smoky honey, toffee, dry seeds, roasted coffee and a rich rounded oak sensation. Big and full flavoured, with caramel, vanilla, cocoa and roasted honey – a strong and rare texture

Dictador XO Insolent 27
