CHAMPAGNE (125ml)

NV Pol Roger – Brut Reserve (Epernay, France) **29**
Classic nose of baked brioche, hazelnuts and superb length, a classy way to start your meal.

NV Laherte & Freres – Rose de Meunier (Chavot, France) **35**
Rich and deep- delicious rose fizz expressing tart red fruit and outstanding aroma. 100% Pinot Meunier, Saignee style. Bone-dry.

SPARKLING (125ml)

2020 Idee Fixe *Blanc de Blancs* (Margaret River, WA) **19**
The new project by Vasse Felix, crafted from premium, free-run cuvee of handpicked Chardonnay and methode-traditionelle winemaking. 20+ months on lees with only 4.6g dosage. Super toasty with lots of baked spices and nuttiness, on the fruit driven side.

NV Rockford – Black Shiraz (Barossa, SA) **36**
Disgorged in 2017, lots of Christmas pudding, dark meaty black berries, dark plums, and chocolate on the nose and palate. A must try.

2019 Joh. Jos. Prüm – Bernkasteler Badstube Kabinett Riesling (Mosel, Germany) 45

Considered as one of the best off-dry Riesling in the world. The balance between acidity and sweetness is out of this world. Thanks, to its natural low alcohol and refreshing character this style of Riesling can be enjoyed as an aperitif, for in between or after some heavy reds

2014 Brokenwood – ILR Semillon (Hunter Valley, NSW) 48

A true Aussie classic, aged Semillon can be marvelous. On the nose super nutty, think toasted macadamia, dried lime, and lemongrass. But there are easily two decades left in the bottle, which will be an amazing journey.

2018 Thibaud Boudignon – A Françoise Anjou Chenin Blanc (Loire Valley, France) 49

A creamy version of Chenin Blanc, aromas of yellow peach, notes of white flowers. The palate is pure, fresh with a saline finish. This wine is an absolute all-rounder and can handle almost all dishes.

2018 William Fevre – Montee de Tonnerre 1^{er} Cru Chardonnay (Chablis, France) 44

One of the greatest vineyards in Chablis, this vintage more body and texture. Still, lots of oyster shell and freshness.

2011 Dm. Leflaive Puligny-Montrachet Chardonnay (Burgundy, France) 72

Domaine Leflaive is world-famous, thanks to their age worthy whites from the best parcels in Burgundy. This is a rare chance to try a mature Puligny-Montrachet, will take a while to open up in your glass.

2015 Dm. Rene Rostaing – La Bonnette Condrieu Viognier (N.Rhône, France) 60

A flower shop in a bottle. This white is a beast full of flavor, which ranges from white and yellow flowers to creamy stone fruit. We suggest giving it a little time in the glass to fully blossom and wow you with intense viscosity.

One of our staff favorites, lots of black fruit with provincial herbs. Fruit-driven but with a lovely earthy nose.			
2018 Rockford – Moppa Springs	Grenache Blend	(Barossa Valley, SA)	19
A fine example of Southern Rhone blend with Aussie magic. Medium bodied, lots of dark fruit, needs some air at this point to highlight....			
2019 Isole E Olena Chianti Classico	Sangiovese	(Tuscany, Italy)	21
A spicy, pure expression of Sangiovese and an authentic chianti classico. Morello dark cherry, fragrant floral aromas of violet, freshly cut herbs.			
2015 Conde Valdemar – Reserva	Tempranillo	(Rioja, Spain)	15
Classic Tempranillo, medium bodied with super smooth tannins. Touch of burnt caramel and vanilla on the nose.			
2019 Dm. Bernard Baudry – Les Grezeaux	Cabernet Franc	(Loire Valley, France)	29
One of our staff favorites, think like Pinot Noir and Cabernet Sauvignon meet in the middle. Lots of black fruit, fresh herbs with crunchy acidity.

Blackcurrant fruit with savoury tones expressing the grape, the second flagship next to the Basket Press Shiraz.			
2016 Yalumba – Menzies	Cabernet Sauvignon	(Coonawarra, SA)	34
Lovely fresh burst of blueberries with a touch of choc mint. An icon from South Australia.

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2014 Dujac & Fils Pinot Noir (Burgundy, France) **72**
Chambolle-Musigny

Jeremy Seysses owns some of the best parcels in Burgundy, this wine combines the fragrance of Chambolle with the power of partial whole-bunch fermentation. A great introduction of Domaine Dujac without breaking the bank.

2014 Dm. Faiveley – Les Porets-St.-George Pinot Noir (Burgundy, France) **63**
Nuits-Saint-George 1er Cru

The tannins of Les Porets are often more masculine and robust and will need some time to soften. Lots of wild dried leaves and mushrooms with dried red fruits on the nose and palate.

2013 Poderi Colla – Bussia Dardi Le Rose Nebbiolo (Piedmont, Italy) **58**
Barolo

Just the aroma alone is worth of trying a glass of aged Nebbiolo. Dried red rose petals, lots of liquorice and a super earthy palate.

2006 Château Mont-Redon Grenache Blend (Southern Rhone, France) **58**
Châteauneuf-du-Pape

This wine is big and juicy, the tannins are soft and round and can handle almost all red meat. Lots of black plum, earthy and gamey notes and lots of spices and dried herbs.

2017 Castello Romitorio Sangiovese (Tuscany, Italy) **57**
Brunello di Montalcino

The grown-up version of Chianti is for many wine lovers a Sangiovese from Brunello, which often has a fleshier texture with primary flavors of black berries, black cherry, chocolate, leather and violets.

2012 Rockford – Basket Press Shiraz (Barossa Valley, SA) **60**

Big, ripe, range and solid, with smoky, meaty black cherry and coffee flavours, dried mint notes. One of the most age worthy Shiraz in Australia.

2012 Dm. E. Guigal – Vignes de L'Hospice Syrah (Northern Rhone, France) **49**
St. Joseph

Dark licorice and warm ganache notes, melding wonderfully with the core of blackberry and confiture flavors. Dried tobacco and cured meat.

2008 Château Certan de May Merlot Blend (Bordeaux, France) **88**
Pomerol

We can trace Merlot back to the 1st Century in France, but as a noble Bordeaux varietal standing on its own doesn't appear till the 1800s. A mix of dried tobacco leaves, graphite and dried plums. Lots of earthiness thanks to Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon in the blend.

2012 Mount Mary Quintet CS|MER|CF|MAL|PV (Yarra Valley, VIC) **85**

Cedar and earth- leafy cabernet fruit, currants, berries, but without much depth or finish. Fine tannins, medium acid. An iconic Bordeaux blend from this humble Victorian producer

RIESLING – A TRIBUTE TO JOS. JOH. PRÜM

Wine is a kind of bottled energy and there is no producer that packs more voltage into their bottles than Joh.Jos.Prüm. The family history in the Mosel dates back as early 1156, though it was Johann Josef Prüm who founded the estate in 1911.

By the mid 1930s the distinctive style had been forged, and from 1969 the imitable Dr. Manfred Prüm would take the reputation job to even greater heights.

Today the estate is run by Manfred's daughter Katharina who watches over 13.5 precious hectares of vines perched on the slate-rich slopes of the Middle Mosel.

All four of Prüm's key vineyards share the same soils – grey and blue Devonian slate. The major differences between the sites have to do with the variation in aspect (from south to south-west facing), the steepness, depth of soil and vine age.

Francois typically restrains his new oak use to about 20%, believing that excessive wood masks full expression of the terroir.

CABERNET FRANC

Franc is lighter than Cabernet Sauvignon, making a bright pale red wine that contributes finesse and lends peppery perfume to blends. Often the grape show cases flavours of black raspberries, tobacco, capsicum, cassis and violets.

Thanks to DNA analysis indicates that Cab Franc is one of the parents of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Carmenere.
